and to ~~his~~ heirs, the said tract above described: ~~To have and to hold~~ the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Arbuckle Nelson*

and to ~~his~~ heirs and assigns forever.
