Papers associated with the 1833 Revolutionary War pension application of Michael Reasor (1760 Frederick Co, VA - 1843 Spencer Co, KY.

This first page is a couple of small documents that reveal that the pension was approved. He received \$60/year starting on March 1834, with arrears to Sep 1832.

The subsequent five pages are a document (that describes Michael Reasor's service, Michael Reasor's own testimony, and the testimony of friends who substantiated that Michael Reasor was who he said he was.

I have not been able to transcribe this document and welcome any help that anyone might offer.
